


### Woodlands Way

*Length: 1.5 Miles*

Difficulty: Easy

This trail follows along the road leading to our yurts. There are some gradual up-and-downs, but the majority of the trail is level with great views of Spruce and Snowy Mountains.

### The Low Road

*Length: 0.8 Miles*

Difficulty: Moderate

This trail follows open fields down a large hill to the flank of Spruce Mountain, where you can access the Spruce Bars Trail or connect with Woodlands Way to complete a 2.5 mile loop.

### Spruce Bars Trail

*Length: 1.5 Miles*

Difficulty: Hard

This trail ends with the best view, but you will have to work for it! The trail gains 320 feet in elevation and is a wooded, single-track. You will also have to back track down to the Low Road.

### Back Ridge Trail

*Length: 0.5 Miles*

Difficulty: Moderate

This trail will allow you to see our iconic main yurts, and a good chance to see wildlife along the way. It takes you past a large sinkhole and the site of the original homestead here. The trail ends where it connects with the Sinkhole and Observatory trails where you can see Spruce Knob, the highest point in West Virginia. The steep hill at the end is not recommended for skis.

### Sinkhole Trail

*Length: 0.2 Miles*

Difficulty: Moderate

This trail allows you to get a closer look at a large collapsed cave entrance, but extreme caution must be used around the marked edge of the sinkhole. This joins up with Back Ridge Trail at the big hill before the Observatory Trail.

### Observatory Trail

*Length: 0.3 Miles*

Difficulty: Easy

This trail leads to the only place here where you can see the summit of Spruce Knob. Also, you will pass our seasonally operated observatory.

### Short Cut Trail

*Length: 0.15 Miles*

Difficulty: Easy

This trail lets you cut between the Low Road and Woodlands Way, and is an easy way to get back to the Woodlands Hostel.
